

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Street photography, a genre of photography that records everyday life in a public place.

The very publicness of the setting enables the photographer to take candid pictures of strangers, often without their knowledge and sometimes in unusual situations.

Street photographers do not necessarily have a social purpose in mind, but they prefer to isolate and capture moments which might otherwise go unnoticed.

"There is a creative fraction of a second when you are taking a picture. Your eye must see a composition or an expression that life itself offers you, and you must know with intuition when to click the camera. That is the moment the photographer is creative. Oop! The Moment! Once you miss it, it is gone forever." – **Henri Cartier-Bresson**
